- 1) Describe your service to the constituents of Colorado to date. Detail how you achieved offices held and your notable accomplishments; particularly your leadership in areas of health care, education, environment, election reform, and civil rights.
- 2) Please describe your legislative agenda for providing affordable health care to all the citizens of Colorado. Specifically speak to your attitude toward single payer solutions.
- 3) Please describe how you will address climate change in the US Senate. Include discussion of these measures with specific reference to and impact on ongoing energy policy.
- 4) What have you done to protect and balance the interests of your constituents with the typically more prominent position and influence of lobbyists and corporate special interests?
- 5) Please describe your attitude on corporate personhood and how you propose to address practically and legislatively.
- 6) How have you and will you continue to seek the regular, active input and feedback of your constituents?
- 7) Discuss your ideas for accelerating the economic recovery, specifically generating long term, permanent gains in employment for Coloradans; and what measures you advocate for guarding against this sort of economic crisis in the future.
- 8) Discuss your assessment of the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan and the long term outlook and US presence/responsibility in each.
- 9) Discuss your assessments of Iran, Israel and a Palestinian State in the stability and security of the US and the Middle East.
- 10) Please identify what will be your 5 highest legislative priorities and why they should be at the top of your list.
- 11) Explain why you are running and uniquely suited for this US Senate seat.
- 12) Discuss your abilities to work with individuals who disagree with you and how you resolve those differences to achieve your goals.
